This intensive workshop featuring cadaveric, live and synthetic models will assist in equipping participants with procedural skills for medical emergencies. It is suitable for ACEM Late Phase Advanced Trainees, Peri-Fellowship Registrars, Fellows and Junior Consultants in Emergency Medicine. Limited places are available for rural General Proceduralists.

Key procedures covered include ICC insertion, difficult airway management, suprapubic insertion, nerve blocks and CVC line insertion utilising ultrasound. This hands-on workshop aims to increase the knowledge and confidence of participants to perform a range of procedures including those which are not routinely performed in the clinical setting. Participants will benefit from the expertise of senior faculty from Emergency Medicine.

The workshop is highly relevant for doctors practising in emergency settings in peripheral, regional or austere environments.
